

**APPLICATION FOR A DECLARATION UNDER  
PART 2 OF THE *SERIOUS AND ORGANISED CRIME (CONTROL) ACT 2008***

To The Honourable the Attorney-General of the State of South Australia

Pursuant to section 8 of the *Serious and Organised Crime (Control) Act 2009* ("the Act") I, **MALCOLM ARTHUR HYDE**, Commissioner of Police for the State of South Australia, apply for a declaration under Part 2 of the *Serious and Organised Crime (Control) Act 2009*.

Details of the application are:

**1. Organisation**

The organisation, the subject of this application is the Rebels Motorcycle Club Australia operating in South Australia, and it is an unincorporated group.

**2. Grounds**

This application is made on the grounds that:

- the members of the organisation associate for the purpose of organising, planning, facilitating, supporting or engaging in serious criminal activity; and
- the organisation represents a risk to public safety and order in South Australia.

**3. Information supporting the grounds of the application**

The application is supported by the information contained in the enclosed statutory declaration of Assistant Commissioner Anthony Gerard Harrison made on 7 December 2009 and Commissioner of Police, Malcolm Arthur Hyde made on 24 September 2009.

**4. Previous application**

No previous application has been made in respect of the organisation referred to in paragraph 1 above.
