Welcome and Registration of Attendance

S Johnson (DTF) welcomed attendees and acknowledged the Aboriginal people as the state's first peoples, nations and Traditional Owners of South Australian land and waters.

Copies of the Agenda and a Record of Attendance sheet were distributed.

Purpose

S Johnson (DTF) explained that today's meeting is the formal commencement of bargaining as per the Notice of Intention (**NOI**); dated 26 November 2019 and sent to applicable employees.

Employee representative organisations, other than the AEU, confirmed that they received formal correspondence, dated 27 November 2019, from the Director, Enterprise Bargaining and that such correspondence enclosed a copy of the NOI.

S Johnson (DTF) provided the AEU with a copy of the correspondence sent to the AEU on 27 November 2019.

N Kitchin (PSA) read and tabled a Statement at the meeting.

Employer's 'key themes'

D Farmer (AEU) asked when the employee representative organisations will be receiving the employer's Management Agenda. S Johnson (DTF) advised the employer is able to discuss its key themes at the next meeting.
