

**NOTICE OF INTENTION TO NEGOTIATE AN ENTERPRISE AGREEMENT UNDER THE
FAIR WORK ACT 1994 (SA)**

**TO EMPLOYEES COVERED BY THE SOUTH AUSTRALIAN PUBLIC SECTOR WAGES PARITY
ENTERPRISE AGREEMENT (PLUMBING, METAL AND BUILDING TRADES EMPLOYEES) 2019**

TAKE NOTICE that the Chief Executive, Attorney General's Department proposes to begin negotiations for a new enterprise agreement.

The proposed date and time for commencement of negotiations is **Monday 29 August 2022 at 11:00am**.

The proposed place for commencement of negotiations is: the **Training Room, Level 1, State Administration Centre, 200 Victoria Square, Adelaide**.

It is proposed that the enterprise agreement will bind employees who meet the following criteria:

1. An employee must have a classification specified within one of the following schedules in Appendix 2: Parity Wages of the *South Australian Public Sector Wages Parity Enterprise Agreement (Plumbing, Metal and Building Trades Employees) 2019*:
 - Schedule 1.1: S.A. Public Sector Plumbers and Gasfitters Award
 - Schedule 1.2: South Australian Government Building Trades Award
 - Schedule 1.3: South Australian Government Departments and Instrumentalities (Metal Trades) Award – Electrical/Electronic Stream
 - Schedule 1.4: South Australian Government Departments and Instrumentalities (Metal Trades) Award – Mechanical Stream
 - Schedule 1.5: South Australian Government Departments and Instrumentalities (Metal Trades) Award – Fabrication Stream
 - Schedule 1.6: Apprentices

AND

2. An employee must be employed in:

Agencies that are administrative units established pursuant to the *Public Sector Act 2009*, including:

- Department for Environment and Water
- Department of Human Services
- Department for Infrastructure and Transport
- Department for Health and Wellbeing (including health services incorporated hospitals and SA Ambulance Service under the *Health Care Act 2008*)
- South Australia Police
- Any other administrative unit as may be established or renamed from time to time pursuant to the *Public Sector Act 2009*.

Other Agencies:

- South Australian Metropolitan Fire Service
- TAFE SA


Employees have the right to be represented in the negotiation of, and in any proceedings for, the approval of, the enterprise agreement by an employee association registered under the *Fair Work Act 1994* or another agent of their choice.

Employees to be involved in these negotiations can gain access to current copies of the relevant industrial instruments, i.e. the *South Australian Public Sector Wages Parity Enterprise Agreement (Plumbing, Metal and Building Trades Employees) 2019*, *S.A. Public Sector Plumbers and Gasfitters Award*, *South Australian Government Building Trades Award* and *South Australian Government Departments and Instrumentalities (Metal Trades) Award 2007*, which currently regulate their

employment, by contacting the Human Resources section of the Agency in which they are employed, or through the internet as follows:

Employees should note that under the *Fair Work Act 1994*, your employer is bound to provide you with a copy of your Award upon request, unless you have previously requested a copy in the last 12 months, or your employer has been relieved of the obligation to provide a copy by the South Australian Employment Tribunal.
