Dear Minister

Thank you for your correspondence dated 15 June 2018 sent on behalf of [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] in relation to crime in the suburb of Walkerville.

I asked South Australia Police (SAPOL) for advice about this matter.

SAPOL review reported crime on a daily basis in order to deploy police resources to where they are most needed. SAPOL will continue to conduct daily analysis of crime trends across the district - including the suburb of Walkerville - and will take appropriate action to reduce crime by use of directed patrols, crime prevention strategies and community engagement to resolve current issues.

On 6 July 2018 a senior SAPOL member contacted [REDACTED] and discussed his concerns. [REDACTED] was advised of SAPOL's continued commitment in working with the community and local key stakeholders to ensure the safety of all residents in the Walkerville area. [REDACTED] appeared satisfied with the contact from SAPOL and stated he will advise [REDACTED] with whom he resides.

The Liberal Marshall Government has recently commissioned an independent review of police work. The purpose of this review will be to reduce red tape so that police can streamline their operations and spend less time on paperwork and more time out protecting our community.

I thank you for bringing this matter to my attention.
